

## PAX A80 Quick Reference Guide

### CREDIT SALE

- From the idle screen, tap **Sale**
- Enter the sale amount and tap **Confirm**
- *Input the tip amount and tap **Confirm**, or enter 0 for no tip, or tap confirm to bypass*
- Insert, Tap, Swipe or manually enter the card account number.
- *Enter Server ID and tap **Confirm***
- Sign card holder signature, tap **Confirm**
- Terminal dials out and receipt prints

### CLOSE BATCH

- From the idle screen, tap **FUNC**
- From the Func Menu, tap **Batch**
- When prompted tap **Batch Close**
- Tap **OK**
- Terminal dials out and receipt prints

### VOID

- From the idle screen, tap **Void**
- Input original transaction number, tap **Confirm**
- *Enter Server ID and tap **Confirm***
- Tap **Confirm** to confirm transaction to be voided
- Sign card holder signature, tap **Confirm**
- Terminal dials out and receipt prints

### REPRINT LAST

- From the idle screen, tap **FUNC**
- From the Func Menu, tap **Print**
- Tap **Print Last**
- Terminal dials out and report prints

### REFUND

- From the idle screen, tap **Refund**
- Select the how the terminal will apply the refund. Select **[By Cardnum]** to use the original card number or select **[RefNo]** to use the original transaction reference number.
- Enter the refund amount and tap **Confirm**
- Swipe or manually enter card number
- *Enter Server ID and tap **Confirm***
- Sign card holder signature, tap **Confirm**
- Terminal dials out and receipt prints

### TIP ADJUST

- From the idle screen, tap **FUNC**
- From the Func Menu, tap **Tip Menu**
- From the Tip Menu tap the search format
- Tap the desired transaction
- Scroll down tap the ADJUST button
- Enter the tip amount and tap Confirm
- Tap OK to confirm tip adjustment
- Terminal dials out and receipt prints
